

How to test your ATM Switch through the by-pass process

Whenever you pilot shuts off after releasing your control knob, it is usually a sign that the anti-tilt switch (also known as the ATM) is faulty.

The following pages include instructions to by-pass the ATM switch, for testing purposes ONLY.

THIS TEST IS FOR DIAGNOSTIC PURPOSES ONLY
NEVER RUN YOUR UNIT WITHOUT ENGAGING THE ATM SWITCH, THIS IS A
SAFETY SWITCH TO SHUT OFF YOUR HEATER IN THE EVENT IT FALLS OVER









Step 1: Remove the tank housing



before starting this process be sure to remove your propane tank

Remove all 4 screws
There are 2 on the front and 2 on the back

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• Step 2

Remove the two lead wires from the ATM switch





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• Step 3

Connect the two female spade connectors, as shown below



Pull down the plastic from the metal spade connectors.



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• Step 4

Turn your heater on.

➤ If your Pilot stays on you will need a new ATM switch.
